- 4. Never use Linoleum Rollers for asphalt.
- 5. When transporting to work area, be sure that the roller is secure with rope or blocks. Due to its weight, it may cause serious injury or damage if allowed to roll around loose.
- 6. Roll from the center of the room to the short side or edges. Then roll the length of the room.
- 7. When an air pocket is impossible to roll out it may become necessary to pierce the covering to allow the air to escape. Caution should be used when doing this as not to distort or damage the floor.
