It's as easy as 1,2,3:

Unload,

Push around property,

Release onto a debris collecting tarp.

There are two release methods, the first uses a hand lever to lift the magnet, the second uses a foot pedal to lift the magnet - thereby releasing the debris.





Renting a Magnetic Broom/Sweeper pays for itself by picking up those loose nails and screws before the end up in your vehicle's tires, or worse.
